

## **WORLDWIDE FOOTPRINT**

KIIT is one of the earliest educational facilities in Odisha, India, to enrol overseas students in its various academic programs. Over 65 nations, including most South Asian countries, send students to the university; 28 schools are co-located on its campus, setting it apart from similar



institutions. This inevitably encourages cross-disciplinary cooperation. The state-of-the-art university is committed to giving a diverse student body educational opportunities for professional, social, and intellectual growth.

### **GLOBAL AND NATIONAL RECOGNITION**

Despite being a young institution - 26 years as an institution and 19 years as a university – KIIT Deemed to be University has achieved impressive positions in international and national rankings of higher education institutions. It is ranked in the cohort of 601-800 by the prestigious Times Higher Education World University Rankings 2023. Its flagship programme - Computer Science Engineering - has been placed in 301-400 band in the Subject Rankings, while General Engineering has achieved a rank of 401-500 in the world. KIIT's B.Tech programmes are accredited by ABET, USA and IET, UK, which are considered as gold standard for engineering and technology education. It has been ranked as the 16th best university in India by the NIRF India Rankings 2023 of the Ministry of Education. It has received the 'A++' Grade from NAAC, the country's top accreditation body for higher education institutions. Its engineering programmes have obtained 'Tier 1' (Washington Accord) accreditation from NBA.
